SDSSAA TO FEATURE BOYS HOCKEY ALL-STAR TILT JANUARY 31st Wednesday, January 29th - For Immediate Release

For the first time in recent memory, the Sudbury District Secondary Schools' Athletic Association boys' senior hockey sport committee will be featuring an all-star game involving the best players from each of twelve of the thirteen teams entered in this year's league.

In what league organizers hope will be an annual feature, the game will be hosted this Friday, January 31st, beginning at 8:00pm in the Tom Davies' Memorial Arena in Walden. Last year's game was cancelled due to weather conditions.

At its January 6th meeting, the league announced the coaching staffs for this game. The East Conference team, comprised of Chelmsford Flyers, Lasalle Lancers, L'Horizon Aigles, Confederation Chargers, Notre Dame Alouettes and Macdonald Cartier Pantheres, will be coached by **Mickey Cooney, Tim Dube and managed by Liane Laquerre** of College Notre Dame.

The West Conference team will be comprised of players from the Manitoulin Mustangs, Espanola Spartans, Lo-Ellen Park Knights, Lockerby Vikings, Lively Hawks and St Benedict Bears, and will be co-coached by Lockerby's **Dave Winsa and Jake Tapper**.

All-Star Subcommittee Chair and Lo-Ellen Coach **Steve Caswell** feels confident the game will be an entertaining one: "Everyone one of these players can play at a high level, but I for one will be interested to see who, if anyone, will stand out amongst the best players in the league. I'm looking forward to a great game."

The lone school not participating in the game this year is the **St Charles Cardinals**, who had committed to an out-of-town tournament.

A list of players that have been named to participate in the game are attached. The league will recognize the three stars of the game in a special post game presentation based on input from all attending coaches.

Admission for the exhibition will be \$2/students and \$3/adult with tickets available for sale at the door.

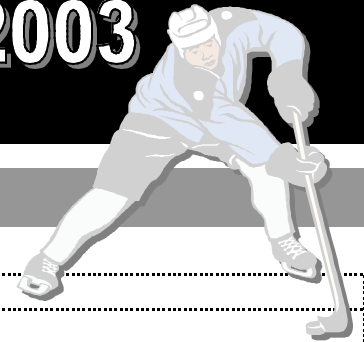
